Sir,

It has been brought to our notice by Prime Minister's Office (**copy enclosed**) that one of the important issues which touched the Hon'ble PM during his Address on Independence Day was "Ease of Living". In order to achieve this, he has suggested building an eco-system thereby minimizing the Govt's interference in the routine life of common Indian citizen.

2. PMO has further informed that though we have taken numerous initiatives in this direction, an exhaustive list can be prepared where improvements can be made in the processes of service related to citizens which can be monitored very closely. In this connection, PMO has requested this Department to make an exhaustive list of such services/areas where simplification can be made which may lead to ease of living.

It is accordingly requested that you may arrange to identify a list of services/areas where further simplification can be made for the ease of living and the same may be **furnished to this Department positively by 9th of September, 2019**. While preparing the list of services/areas, it may kindly be ensured that only those services/areas may be included where the same can be effectively followed up on a monthly basis.
