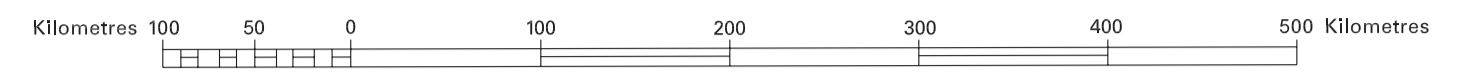


भारत का प्राकृतिक मानचित्र PHYSICAL MAP OF INDIA

Scale 1:4,00,000 or 1 Centimetre to 40 Kilometres

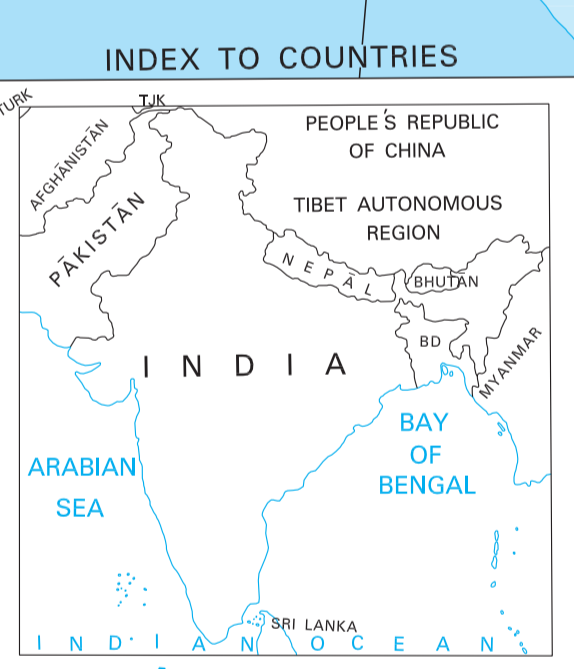

HEIGHTS AND DEPTHS IN METRES

The administrative headquarters of Chandigarh, Haryana and Puducherry are at Chandigarh.
The interstate boundaries between Andhra Pradesh, Assam and Meghalaya shown on this map are as interpreted from the North-Eastern Areas (Reorganisation) Act, 1971 but have to be verified.
The territorial waters of India extend into the sea to a distance of twelve nautical miles measured from the appropriate base line.
