Notification

G.S.R...... In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Science and Technology, Department of Science and Technology, Survey of India, (Group 'C' Ministerial posts) Recruitment Rules, 2018, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Upper Division Clerk and Lower Division Clerk in the Survey of India, Department of Science and Technology under Ministry of Science and Technology, namely:-

- **1. Short title and commencement.** (1) These rules may be called the Survey of India, Upper Division Clerk and Lower Division Clerk, Recruitment Rules, 2023.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of posts, classification, level in pay matrix. –The number of said posts, their classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- **3.** Method of recruitment, age-limit and other qualifications, etc. The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the Schedule annexed to these rules
- 4. Disqualification. No person, -
- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied, that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- **5. Power to relax.** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 6. Saving. Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled

Tribes, the other Backward Classes, the Ex-servicemen and the other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
