This office has been directed vide SG's letter No.E1-1942/579-Rules/LDCE dated 18-04-2022 to conduct the subject examination for filling of vacancies accrued for the years from 2017 to 2022 of Officer Surveyor Posts by **single selection examination** as per existing LDCE (Selection of Officer Surveyor Grade) Scheme -1991 and copy of cited SG's letter is enclosed herewith for circulation among all concerned category staff for their information and guidance.

The year-wise vacancies to be filled through subject single examination are shown in the following table :

- 2. The above vacancies are subject to the outcome of orders of Hon'ble Courts in the following cases:
 - a) OA. No. 1506/2018 filed by Shri P.M. Krishna V/s Union of India and others before the Hon'ble CAT, Madras Bench, Chennai. However, the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Madras has ordered to maintain status quo vide order dated 10-12-2018 in W.P. No. 31893/2018 filed by Shri P.M. Krishna.
 - b) O.A.No. 388 of 2018 filed by Shri Akash Ranjan Singh in the Hon'ble CAT, Patna Bench, Patna.
 - c) O.A.No. 519 of 2018 filed by Shri Jasbir Singh Bangari V/s Union of India & others before the Hon'ble Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench.

- 3. The Addl.SGs of all the zones are requested to send the consolidated list of eligible candidates alongwith the application forms of willing and eligible candidates as per enclosed proforma (vide Annexure-I) after obtaining from the concerned GDCs duly certified by the Director/Dy. Surveyor General of concerned GDC about the correctness of various particulars of applicants on verifying the same from the service records of the concerned, so as to reach this office on or before <u>04th July 2022</u> by e-mail (iism.soi@gov.in). Names received from the concerned office after <u>04th July 2022</u> will not be considered and the application forms which are found to be incomplete will be rejected.
- 4. The Directors of GDC's are requested to circulate this notification and to make necessary arrangements to send the applications of the willing and eligible candidates from their GDC's on priority basis to this office through the concerned Zonal Head by the above mentioned date. The eligible candidates away on deputation / training / field duty, if any, may also be informed about this matter. If there are no willing /eligible candidates, a **NIL report is also required to be sent**.
- 5. The Roll Nos. with details in respect of eligible candidates will be sent to concerned GDCs through email with necessary instructions for handing over the same to the candidates after scrutiny of the applications in this office.
- 6. Eligibility for appearing in the Examination: Those Surveyors / Survey Assistants who have completed 5 years regular service in the grade of Surveyors / Survey Assistant as on the crucial date for eligibility (as mentioned below) and in possession of a Bachelor's Degree with Mathematics as one subject as stipulated in LDCE Scheme1991 shall be eligible to appear in the examination. The crucial dates for eligibility (excluding the period of basic training if any) will be as under:-

1st Jan, 2017 for 2017 Examination 1st Jan, 2018 for 2018 Examination 1st Jan, 2019 for 2019 Examination 1st Jan, 2020 for 2020 Examination 1st Jan, 2021 for 2021 Examination 1st Jan, 2022 for 2022 Examination

The cumulative vacancies of these six years will be filled through a Single Selection Examination as mentioned in Para 1.

- 7. The examination will be conducted as per the existing LDCE Scheme 1991 and as per the modified syllabus issued vide SG's letter No. E1-13751/1968- Exam dated 10-10-2011.
- 8. The Written Examination will be conducted in two Phases: Preliminary Qualifying Examination (PQE) and Main Examination. Those who qualify in the PQE will only be allowed to appear in the Main Examination. There will be two Papers in PQE: General English (Paper I) and General Knowledge & Current Affairs (Paper II) which are of qualifying nature only. There will be two Papers in the Main Examination: Pure Mathematics (Paper III) and Applied Mathematics & Physics (OR) Surveying (Paper IV). All the four Papers of PQE and Main Examination are of objective type. The system of negative marking will be followed in respect of Papers III & IV of Main Examination. The OMR method of answering will be followed in r/o. all the four papers of PQE and Main Examination.
- 9. The Venue of the Examination for both PQE and Main Examination will be NIGST (erstwhile IIS&M), Hyderabad.
- 10. The PQE will be held on <u>19-07-2022</u> (Paper I in the forenoon and Paper II in the afternoon). The Main Examination will be held after 2 weeks from the date of PQE. The exact date of Main Examination will be intimated after completion of PQE. Candidates are advised to make their Examination preparation accordingly.

- 11. Before undertaking the evaluation of papers I & II of PQE, the Key for both the Papers I & II of PQE will be displayed /uploaded on the official website of SoI (www.surveyofindia.gov.in) on 19-07-2022 (A/N) after the examination. All the Candidates are advised to go through the keys displayed on the website. The objections on the answer keys, if any, have to be submitted by the candidates with full details from their Govt. email IDs to this office email (iism.soi@gov.in) by 21-07-2022 (upto 10:00 hrs.). The objections (on the Answer Keys displayed) which are found to be vague and not clear will be ignored. If no objections are received before above mentioned date, the key displayed earlier will be treated as final and further action will be taken. In case of any valid objections received on the answer keys displayed, the same will be studied by the board for taking appropriate action and issue a necessary amendment to the answer key, if required.
- 12. The same system/ procedure for displaying of answer keys will be adopted in respect of Papers III & IV of Main Examination before undertaking the evaluation of Papers of Main Examination. Accordingly, candidates are advised to check the SoI website from time to time about the display of Answer Keys in respect of PQE & Main Examination.
- 13. The list of candidates who qualify in the PQE will be displayed on SOI website on completion of evaluation of Papers I & II.
- 14. Those who qualify in the Main Exam as per the various provisions of existing LDCE Scheme will only be called for Interview / Assessment of Confidential Reports. The list of Candidates qualified for interview will be displayed on the SOI website after completion of evaluation of Main Examination.
- 15. The Date & Venue for conducting of interview / Assessment of Confidential Reports in respect of those Candidates who qualify for interview / Assessment of Confidential Reports will be communicated separately.
- 16. Additional instructions required if any, will be issued in due course of time.



5. Those Surveyors and Survey Assistants who have completed 05 years regular service in the grade of Surveyor and Survey Assistant as on the crucial date for eligibility (as mentioned below) and have the minimum educational qualification etc. as stipulated in LDCE Scheme shall be eligible to appear at the examination. The crucial dates for eligibility will be as under:-

1st Jan, 2017 for 2017 Examination

1st Jan, 2018 for 2018 Examination

1st Jan, 2019 for 2019 Examination

1st Jan, 2020 for 2020 Examination

1st Jan, 2021 for 2021 Examination

1st Jan, 2022 for 2022 Examination

- A candidate eligible for appearing in any year's examination is also eligible for subsequent year's examination subject to fulfillment of all other eligibility conditions.
- After the examination, a consolidated merit list for all the vacancies for 6 years i.e. 2017 to 2022 will be prepared. However, the results shall be declared separately for each year to ensure that if vacancies remain unfilled in any of the year (i.e. 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020 & 2021), the same are carried forward to next vacancy year. Year wise merit lists will be based on the number of vacancies, candidate's position in consolidated merit list and fulfillment of all other eligibility conditions. Based on his/her merit, and subject to vacancy position and other eligibility conditions, a candidate will be placed in the appropriate year wise select list. If a candidate's name is included in the select list for a particular category for a particular year, his/her name will not be considered for inclusion in other list(s). Vacancies remaining unfilled in any of the years due to non-availability of suitable/qualified candidates, will be carried forward to the next Vacancy year.
- 7. Select list of candidates for each year including candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes will be decided based on the guidelines to be issued by the Department of Personnel & Training as per the outcome of the pending litigation in SLP (C) No. 30621/2011 and SLP (C) No. 31288/2017.
- 8. Candidate should clearly make aware that this is a competitive and not a qualifying examination. The number of persons to be included in each Select list based on the result of the examination is entirely within the competence of Government to decide. No candidate will therefore have any claim for inclusion in the Select List on the basis of his/her performance in this Examination as a matter of right.
- To conduct the said exam further guidelines are issued as under:-
 - Three sets of question papers are to be prepared of which one set is to be randomly selected by the Board.
 - Evaluation of answer sheets is to be done by the Board and the final result to be submitted to SGO.
 - iii. The complete process of selection must be completed by August, 2022.
